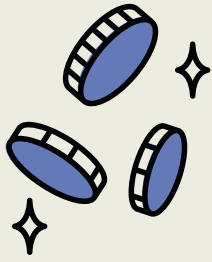
Donations help make these options a reality and helps spread information further.

- * **Donate to Fund Pills and Providers.** A few abortion funds are also working hard to ensure cost is never a barrier when people access pills by mail: right now these include Abortion Freedom Fund, Cobalt, and WRAP. The film was shot between 2018 and 2022, capturing a pivotal moment in the history of abortion pills. But this is an ever evolving landscape. Since this film was made, many things have changed:

- * New "Shield laws" are making it possible for US-based providers to mail pills over state lines into all restricted states, with sliding scale cost and 3-5 day ship time.
- * This means abortion pills by mail are more available than ever in restricted states, from licensed clinicians with FDA approved pills, all for \$150 or less. This is big news.
- * Community Networks like **Red State Access** and **Las Libres** are meeting the needs of people who can't afford other services, by mailing pills into restricted states at no cost. They are serving a significant number of people every month.
- * In short: pills are proliferating, with new and improved ways to access them. The Plan C Guide stays updated with what's currently available: plancpills.org/guide

QUESTIONS:

- * What are your initial reactions and feelings after watching PLAN C? What did you learn that you didn't know before?
- * While the experts in the film confirm that self-managed abortion with pills is medically safe and widely practiced around the world, what are the risks in the US? How do these risks vary depending on a person's identity, where they live and who they live with?
- * Why is it important for abortion clinics to remain open if pills are available by mail?
- * How does abortion access impact your life, whether or not you have had the procedure yourself? How does it intersect with other things you and your watch party care about?
- * Francine is quoted in the film saying: "We have made the decision that we're not going to become more quiet. We'll become louder." How can you get louder in helping people understand that abortion pills are available by mail in every state—even states with bans—as well as countering laws that unjustly restrict abortion access?
